ART SHOW REGULATIONS

The Huron County Art Show and Sale is an initiative designed to collect local art for the Huron County Art Bank and to promote local art and artists.

Submitted artwork must be received by the Huron County Museum by 4:30 pm on Saturday, September 30, 2017.

ART REGULATIONS

All submitted artwork must be the artist's original work, in one or more of the following medias:

- Painting and Mixed Media: Oil, Acrylic, Watercolour, Assemblage, Encaustic
- Fiber & Material Arts: Textile and Fiber Arts, Jewelry, Basketry
- 3- Dimensional Arts: Woodworking, Sculpture, Pottery
- Works on Paper: Printmaking, Drawing, Pastel, Collage
- Photography: Film, Digital, Manipulated Images

The subject matter must have some relevance to Huron County.

THEME FOR THE 2017 SHOW IS "MY CANADA" IN CELEBRATION OF CANADA 150.

Submitted work must not have been displayed in the previous two Huron County Art Shows.

A limit of one work of art per artist is permitted.

There is a \$10.00 non-refundable admission fee.

All paintings, works on paper and photography must arrive at the Huron County Museum framed and ready to hang. All artworks must be ready to be installed.

- Exterior frames are required to protect the artwork which will need to be transported to other county buildings and placed on public display if they are one of the winning entries. Gallery wrap is not considered acceptable framing.
- Hanging systems must be to professional standards (wires or loops must be sufficient to carry the weight of the artwork).

All work exhibited must remain at the Huron County Museum for the entire duration of the show.

All work exhibited will be insured by the Huron County Museum for the duration of the show.

The Huron County Museum reserves the right to refuse any work:

- If it is considered unsuitable and/or does not meet these guidelines.
- If it cannot be accommodated safely or comfortably within the gallery space.

ARTIST INFORMATION

The artist must be a full-time resident, seasonal resident or ratepayer of Huron County.

Each artist will be required to sign a statement of Huron County residency.

The artist will be required to fill out a description and release form for each work of art submitted.

Please provide a short artist statement/explanation for your artwork to be included in the show.

CONDITIONS OF EXHIBITION

The County of Huron and Huron County Museum & Historic Gaol reserves the right to use the artist's name, likeness, photograph of work, and the fact that the artist participated in the exhibit for promotional purposes.

The artist holds the County of Huron and the Huron County Museum & Historic Gaol, their employees and volunteers, harmless from any breach of copyrights in Canada, USA and elsewhere.

The County of Huron and Huron County Museum & Historic Gaol hold the right to display and exhibit artworks purchased for the Huron County Art Bank in public county spaces.

Future use of winning artworks held within the Art Bank for advertising, promotion, or sales will be negotiated with the original artist or according to Canadian copyright regulations.



AWARDS AND PRIZES

A purchase award of \$1000 and \$800 will be given to the first and second place winning entries as selected by the Judge, respectively. Judge's selection is final.

The entries awarded first and second place will then become the property of the Corporation of the County of Huron and become part of the Huron County Art Bank.

Up to six honourable mentions will be named – these entries will not receive a cash award and will be returned to the artist at the conclusion of the show.

Awards will be presented at the opening reception.

ART SALES

Those works not awarded first or second prize may be offered for sale by the artist.

On all works sold during the show, Huron County Museum will add 20% for commission and applicable tax (HST) in addition to the price set by the artist. Please price your artwork accordingly.

All work included in the show and not purchased for the Art Bank may be retrieved on December 18 & 19 during the established pick-up schedule. Artists will be advised of the schedule by phone in December.
